# **Technical Specificities**

All entries must be 1 page only. If images are used, they must be 300 dpi resolution.

Entries must have been created with Tasmeem, Adobe InDesign Middle Eastern version and at least one of the 16 Tasmeem Fonts. Other design or desktop publishing tools may be used if desired.

Tasmeem and Adobe InDesign Middle Eastern version are available in free time-limited versions on the WinSoft website: www.winsoft-international.com/en/downloads/trials.

# The Jury

Winners will be decided by a two-fold process.

Contestants will be judged by a panel of experts in the field of design and Middle Eastern culture and tradition. Results will depend on the overall impact of the submitted work, typographic skills and creativity.
