## Corrigendum

Paragraph 11 should read

11. The UNFCCC could play a facilitative role in these collaborative R&D activities rather than overseeing or managing these activities. By far the most collaborative R&D would be undertaken at the international and national levels through a variety of public and private entities. For example, the UNFCCC could facilitate these activities after the identification of key gaps through a top-down analysis of existing activities and programmes; at the same time, the process should also be responsive to a bottom-up identification of needs through technology needs assessments (TNAs), nationally appropriate mitigation actions and other existing activities.
