# 1 Culture et diversité culturelle



#### RESPECT DE LA DIVERSITE CULTURELLE

Johannesburg: Plan de mise en oeuvre

« §5. La paix, la sécurité, la stabilité et le respect des droits de l'homme et des libertés fondamentales, notamment le droit au développement, ainsi que **le respect de la diversité culturelle**, sont essentiels pour assurer un développement durable et faire en sorte que ce type de développement profite à tous. »

#### Rio:

Nous reconnaissons la diversité culturelle et naturelle du monde et affirmons que toutes les cultures et civilisations peuvent contribuer au développement durable

 35. We acknowledge the natural and cultural diversity of the world and recognize that all cultures and civilizations can contribute to sustainable development. [Agreed ad ref]

#### Patrimoine

- 25. We recognize that many people, especially the poor, depend directly on ecosystems for their livelihoods, their economic, social and physical well-being, and <u>their</u> <u>cultural heritage.</u>

#### PATRIMOINE NATUREL ET CULTUREL

- 52. We affirm that green economy policies in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication should:
- (g)enhance the welfare of indigenous peoples and their communities and other local communities, recognizing and supporting their identity, <u>culture</u> <u>and interests and avoid endangering their cultural heritage and</u> <u>traditional knowledge</u>
- Cities 1. We recognize that, if planned and developed soundly including through integrated planning and management approaches, cities..... We also recognize the need <u>for conservation as appropriate of the natural and</u> <u>cultural heritage of human settlements, the revitalization of historic</u> <u>districts, and the rehabilitation of city centres.</u>

# Cadre décennal de programmes sur les MCPD

SCP 8. We agree to adopt the 10-Year Framework of Programmes (10YFP) on sustainable consumption and production (SCP), appended to this Declaration. Furthermore, we encourage contributions to the 10YFP trust fund intended to support developing countries in promoting sustainable consumption and production.

# 3. Responsabilité sociale et environnementale



## Responsabilité et entreprises

40. We acknowledge the implementation of sustainable development will depend on active engagement of both the public and private **sectors.** We recognize that the active participation of the private sector can contribute to the achievement of sustainable development, including through the important tool of public-private partnerships. We support regulatory and policy frameworks that enable business and industry to advance sustainable development initiatives in accordance with national legislation and objectives, taking into account the importance of applying standards of corporate social responsibility and accountability.

- 41. We acknowledge the importance of <u>corporate</u> <u>sustainability reporting and, encourage</u> <u>companies, where appropriate, especially publically listed and large companies, to integrate sustainability information into their reporting cycle,...</u>

# . Emploi

24. We express deep concern about the continuing high levels of unemployment and underemployment, particularly among <u>young</u> <u>people</u>, and note the need for sustainable development strategies to <u>proactively address</u> <u>youth employment</u> and stress the need for the development of a global strategy on youth employment.

# Participation

 26. We emphasize that sustainable development must be inclusive and people-centered, benefiting and involving all people, <u>including</u>

44. We stress the importance of <u>the active participation of</u> <u>young people in decision making processes</u> as the issues we are addressing have a deep impact on present and future generations, and as the **contribution of children and youth** is vital to the achievement of sustainable development. # 5. Education, formation, recherche



Education 4. We urge <u>educational institutions</u> to become models of best practice and to <u>enlist the</u> <u>active participation of all students, teachers and other staff, their local partners and other stakeholders</u> in setting an example of sustainability on their campuses and in their communities. We encourage educational institutions to teach sustainable development <u>as an integrated</u> <u>component across disciplines</u>.

Education 2. We recognize that the younger generations are the custodians of the future, as well as the need for better quality and access beyond primary education. We therefore resolve to improve the capacity of our education systems to prepare people to pursue sustainable development, including through enhanced teacher training, the development of curricula around sustainability, ...;and more effective use of information and communication technologies to enhance learning outcomes. We call for enhanced cooperation among schools, communities and authorities in efforts to promote access to quality education at all levels. Agreed ad ref

# 6. Information, Innovation et TIC

In this regard, it is essential to work towards improved access to ICT, especially broadband networks and services, and bridge the digital divide, recognizing the importance od international cooperation in this regard.

# Recherche et Innovation

- 65. We recognize the critical role of technology as well as the importance of **promoting innovation**, also in developing countries. We invite governments, as appropriate, **to create enabling frameworks that foster** environmentally sound technology, R&D and innovation..
- Jobs 7. We recognize that opportunities for the greening of existing jobs and job creation can be availed through, inter alia, public and private investments in scientific and technological innovation, public works in restoring, regenerating and conserving natural resources and ecosystems, and social and community services......
